The Pulpit Minister/Evangelist

- Must be a visionary leader guided by the Holy Spirit.
- Will be a devoted disciple of Jesus Christ who is passionate about helping others to live, grow as disciples, and understand the discipleship-making concept.
- Will live a life that demonstrates a passionate faith in God, strong commitment to the Lordship of Jesus Christ, guidance of the Holy Spirit, and authority of the scriptures.
- Will work and support the vision of the church, under the oversight of the elders and serve as a member of the Ministry Team.
- Must be a model that demonstrates a faithful Christian and always sets a proper example of Christian behavior.
- Must be accountable to God, Jesus Christ, members, and elders.
- Must prepare and deliver effective, spiritually sound Sunday sermons.
- Must teach at Bible Studies, lead, and/or participate in devotional services.
- Must coordinate with the ministry team, staff, and elders.
- Provide updates and status reports to eldership. (monthly status reports and/or as requested).
- Must maintain availability by phone.
- Must have the ability to use various communication platforms to share the word of God.

Expectations

- Must be a visionary with proven ability to lead and mobilize church growth.
- Develop relationships outside the church and within the community.
- Participate in community activities.
- Demonstrate a passion for discipleship ministry.
- Advise elders of any special problems, issues, and/or conflicts with the congregation in a timely manner.
- Must be a solid, sound preacher/teacher of the Word of God. (Be instant in and out of season - 2 Timothy 4:2)
- Attend scheduled church services and fellowships.
- Assist in equipping members for discipleship growth.
- Develop sermons that edify, strengthen, and encourage introspection that leads members to further study of God's word.

Qualifications

- Member of the Church of Christ.
- Ministry degree with Bible major is preferred, but applicants without a degree who have demonstrated successful ministry experience will be considered.
- Minimum of 5 - 7 years of preaching experience.
- Strong faith and commitment to the call of serving the Lord as a pulpit minister and evangelist.
- Biblical knowledge at a proficient level and ability to communicate to congregation.
- Excellent interpersonal skills, both verbal and written.
- Ability to work with people of diverse and multi-generational backgrounds.
- Demonstrated ability to lead bible classes.
- Ability to organize activities, communicate ideas, and use time effectively.
- Proven track record of evangelism and ministry.
- Effective servant leader of Jesus Christ.
